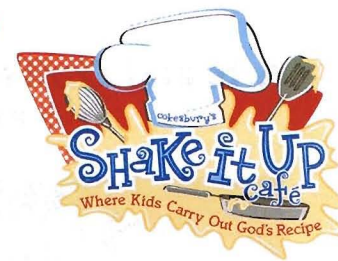

I will cause your name to be celebrated in all generations; therefore the peoples will praise you forever and ever.

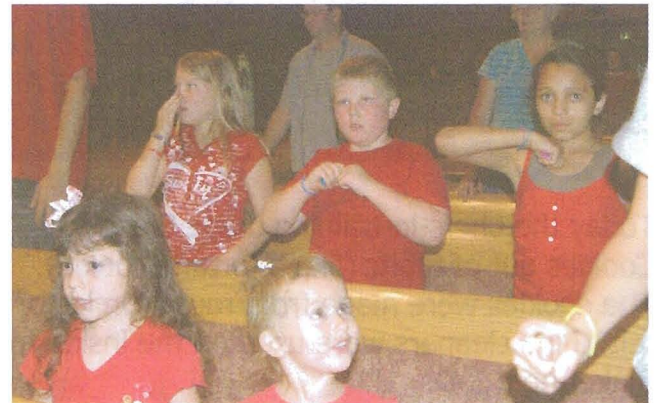
Foodology Factory

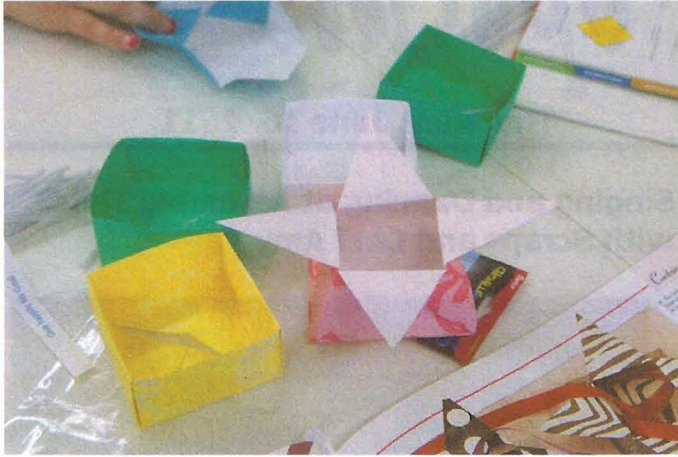

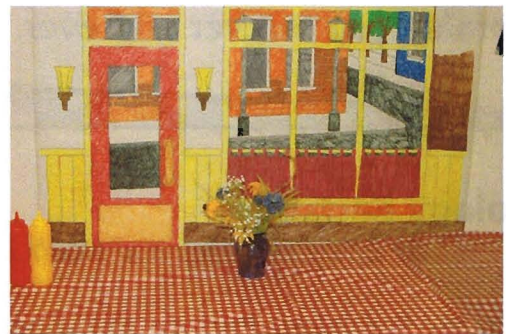
They played musical chairs for the rest of their music time, and it was fun! "I love to see the kids sing and dance", said Anjelica.

THURSDAY'S COLOR WAS BLUE!



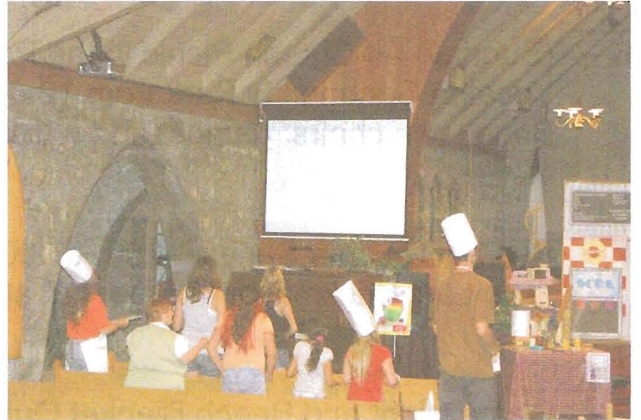


Today's Story
