November 6-15, 2015

From repairing roads, to building a roof, painting a home and painting bunkbeds for giants are only a glimpse of the arduous tasks they worked on, hand in hand with our local staff. Their servant hearts and hands were visuals of Christ on earth.

We celebrated our second Regional Health Meeting. Our health works were provided continued education and the topic was Thanatology. Dr. Minerva Hernández from Public Health Services of the state of Puebla gave the topic from a medical point of view and Reverend Raquel Balbuena covered the same topic

from a spiritual stand point. Their speeches were powerful, practical and emotional. The women had many questions related to this topic and they were all addressed. The health workers received their first aid kit replacements. It was a wonderful experience for everyone!

We hosted an Ecological Retreat led by Reverend Isaias Ramos from “El Mesias” Methodist Church . This group learned various practical technologies in which they could positively impact communities.

A family from Huehuetlán was provided a pig to begin pig raising as a means of income.

We gave the Fuel Efficient Mud Stove Workshop to community members from Huehuetlán.

Guided Tours were provided to: José María Morelos Elementary School and members from the community of Chietla.

December 19th, 2015

We provided transportation to “El Buen Pastor” Methodist Church and were able to participate in the distribution of 260 blankets for the indigenous rural communities of Ixtepec and Huitzilán, Puebla.



December 26-30, 2015

We will be hosting children from “El Getsemani” Methodist Church, Tlancualpicán and “El Divino Salvador” Methodist Church, Don Roque for a Christmas Vacation Bible School. Keep us in your prayers.


We continue with the effort to raise funds for projects below. If you have not supported any of these initiatives below we encourage you to support these efforts for they are for the wellbeing of the least of these.
