LIFE IN A CUP

In King David's beloved Psalm 23, he alluded to the many hardships he endured with a few simple phrases. He walked through the valley of deep darkness while Saul hunted him; his own son Absalom rebelled against him, among other trials. God also disciplined David through the human rod of the Prophet Nathan after he sinned by taking Bathsheba, the wife of his loyal general. He was in the presence of many enemies within and without—members of his own household, foreign rulers, and rival kings—yet David concludes the psalm with a remarkable declaration: "My cup overflows." It is a profound statement of faith, especially considering how often his cup seemed nearly empty and his life hung in the balance.

If our lives were compared to a cup, how would we assess its condition? We may choose an optimistic outlook and say it is half full or we may focus on what is lacking and call it half empty; the cup itself may remain unchanged, but optimism strengthens and inspires, while pessimism discourages and diminishes hope. There is, however, an even greater perspective: to recognize the hand of God filling what is lacking in our cup. His grace overcomes our deficiencies and supplies our deepest needs. As he said to Paul, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9). Therefore, regardless of our circumstances, we too can say with confidence, "My cup overflows."

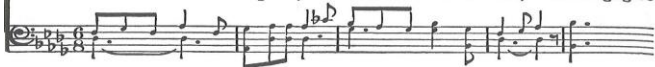

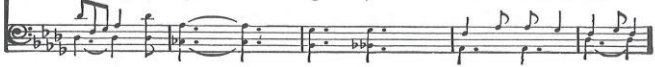

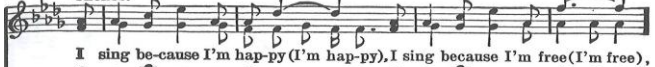
