GUARDIAN ANGELS

After Hagar, Sarah's servant, became pregnant with Ishmael, Hagar despised Sarah, and they could not coexist peacefully. An angel of the Lord appeared to Hagar, instructed her to return, and assured her of blessings for her descendants. Hagar named God and declared, "You are the God who sees me" (Genesis 16:13). Eventually, Sarah gave birth to Isaac, and Hagar and Ishmael were compelled to leave their residence. Once more, an angel appeared to Hagar and reaffirmed God's blessing (Genesis 21:18). Hagar was merely a servant in Abraham's household and would not have anticipated encountering God's messenger; nonetheless, God cared for her and sent angels to guide her.

Angels serve as ministering spirits sent to accompany believers, paralleling the work of God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. God never leaves us nor forsakes us. Jesus incarnated as Immanuel (God with us) and promised to be with us until the end through the Holy Spirit, who is the constant companion of believers. God's abiding presence goes hand in hand with guardian angels. Jesus said that children have angels who always see God. (Matthew 18:10)

Life occasionally presents circumstances akin to Hagar's situation. We may feel entirely alone as we confront harsh realities; however, such feelings are merely perceptions. Although we may not see God, He sees us and helps us through guardian angels.
