SPIRITUAL RESPONSIBILITY

Amos prophesied, “The days are coming,” declares the Sovereign Lord, “when I will send a famine through the land—not a famine of food or a thirst for water, but a famine of hearing the words of the Lord” (Amos 8:11). Amos ministered during a time of peace and prosperity in both the Northern and Southern kingdoms of Israel, yet he warned of dire consequences for neglecting God’s word. This prophecy illuminates Jesus’ teaching in Matthew 25 on feeding the hungry. The righteous ask, “Lord, when did we see you hungry and thirsty?” Jesus replies, “Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.” The least of Jesus’ brothers and sisters includes those who suffer spiritual hunger for God’s living bread.

Ministering to physical needs is noble and necessary, but believers are also called to recognize the far greater tragedy of spiritual starvation. We are commissioned to confront this famine by offering the living bread of God to a world starving for truth and grace. This ministry of spiritual nourishment is so essential that Jesus declares it will be among the criteria by which he separates the sheep from the goats when he returns. Therefore, preaching the word of God faithfully—as it is written, in season and out of season—is not merely an option but a sacred obligation. God desires that no one perish, but that everyone come to repentance and receive the life that only Christ, the living manna, can give.

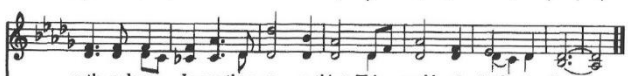
